

## \*\*\* Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS) \*\*\*

Starting Saturday, August 11, 2007, the online version of the Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS) will be offered on an appointment basis four days a week at San Diego State University. Used by nursing schools throughout the United States, the exam is multiple-choice and consists of the following sections:

Reading	50 minutes	40 questions
Mathematics	56 minutes	45 questions
Science	38 minutes	30 questions
English	65 minutes	55 questions

While the total testing time is 3 hours and 29 minutes, please allow a few additional minutes for online check-in. The location of the exam will be the Office of Student Testing, Assessment and Research, Student Services West 2549.

During the Fall, 2007 semester, the exam will be given at the following times:

Thursdays	9:00 a.m.
Fridays	9:00 a.m.
Saturdays	8:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m.

To be admitted to the test, the candidate must have a current government-issued identification with a photo and signature, such as a driver's license, passport, military ID, government ID, or alien residency (green) card. No food, drink, books, notes, or electronic devices are permitted in the testing room.

The cost of the exam is \$40, payable the day of the exam. Payment methods are cash, check or money order made out to "SDSU". Credit card payments are acceptable for weekday exams only at this time.
